GIST OF ACCIDENT

AT 1930, 2-9-04 I RESPONDED TO THE REPORT OF A CAR INTO A TREE. WHEN I ARRIVED I NOTED THE ABOVE VEHICLE PARKED FACING WEST IN THE EASTBOUND LANE OF WILD AMMONOOSUC RD (RT 112). THE VEHICLE WAS LOCKED AND THERE WAS NO ONE IN THE AREA. I SPOKE TO A WITNESS WHO TOLD ME THERE WAS A YOUNG FEMALE BEHIND THE WHEEL AND THERE WERE NO OTHER PEOPLE IN THE VEHICLE. HE SPOKE WITH THE FEMALE WHO TOLD HIM NOT TO CALL POLICE.

EVIDENCE AT THE SCENE INDICATED THE VEHICLE HAD BEEN EASTBOUND AND HAD GONE OFF THE ROADWAY, STRUCK SOME TREES, SPUN AROUND, AND CAME TO REST FACING THE WRONG WAY IN THE EASTBOUND LANE. THE DRIVERS SIDE OF THE WINDSHIELD WAS CRACKED AND BOTH FRONT AIR BAGS HAD DEPLOYED.

IN PLAIN SIGHT BEHIND THE DRIVERS SEAT OF THE VEHICLE I COULD SEE A BOX OF FRANZIA WINE. I COULD ALSO SEE RED LIQUID ON THE DRIVERS SIDE DOOR AND CEILING OF THE CAR.

I MADE A SEARCH OF THE ROADWAY IN THE AREA OF THE ACCIDENT. I WAS ASSISTED BY FIRE, EMS PERSONNEL AND A RESIDENT OF THE AREA. THE DRIVER WAS NOT LOCATED. A LATER SEARCH OF THE VEHICLE INDICATED THE DRIVER WAS MAURA MURRAY.

WHEN THE VEHICLE WAS TOWED FROM THE SCENE BY LAVOIE'S I RECOVERED A COKE BOTTLE THAT CONTAINED A RED LIQUID WITH A STRONG ALCOHOLIC ODOOR.
